The road to Calvary was not a smooth and the pain He endured in exchange for us was more than a passion. It was a sign of His true and honest love. When these men tore the garments from Yeshua all wounds must have reopened and as they threw over his shoulder an old scarlet mantle which barely reached his knees. They brutally dragged him to the seat prepared, and pushed him roughly down upon it, having first placed the crown of thorns upon his head. The crown of thorns was made of three branches plaited together, with the greatest part of the thorns being purposely turned inwards so as to pierce our Lord Yeshua's head. Having first placed these twisted branches on his forehead, they tied them tightly together at the back of his head, and no sooner was this accomplished to their satisfaction than they put a large reed into his hand, doing all with derisive gravity as if they were really crowning Him king. They then seized the reed, and struck his head so violently that his eyes were filled with blood; they knelt before him, derided him, spat in his face, and buffeted him, saying at the same time, 'Hail, King of the Jews!' Then they pulled him up again from the ground on which he had fallen, and reseated Him with the greatest possible brutality. Yeshua's sufferings were inexpressible; but it was by them that he merited for us the grace necessary to resist those temptations to despair which will assail us at the hour of death.

I can only imagine what Mary endured along the way. Her tolerances ashen and pale while her eyes red with weeping, but the simple dignity notwithstanding her grief and anguish, notwithstanding the fatigue which she had endured. I see her in my own vision as her dress moistened by the morning dew which had fallen upon it during the night, and by the tears which she had shed in such abundance and almost beside herself from sorrow. She saw everything and could do nothing, and nothing could have been worse than her agonizing grief, knowingly it had to be fulfilled to reveal the truth. The courage and firmness of Mary remained unshaken even in the midst of her inexpressible anguish she had to endure.

But with over joy we know it did not all end at the cross but the victorious glory came upon Yeshua when He rose from the dead and claim His rightfully place as King and Saviour for all.

What inspire you the most always has a challenge and it can be influenced the way of your everyday thinking. Your desire should be, to endure and run the full race right unto the end.

When our minds, weakened by our own negative thoughts, have lost the power of reasoning, and even our hopes of mercy and forgiveness cause uncertainty, think of the purpose Yeshua done this, everything He endured through His Passionate love for us, though His prayer He overcome all evil, His patience and persistence to have victory instead of failure.
